




**Annual Report
2013-2014**




2013-2014 in numbers

- 50 Early childhood Development (ECD) Centres' Practitioners benefited from our weekly ECD workshops
- 3074 children attending these centres have benefited from the Dinaledi Project
- 1250 Gr. Rs followed our grade R curriculum compiled to improve their school readiness
- 16 centres and 1250 children benefited from the Centre Facilities Upgrade Programme
- 50 ECD Centres benefited Centre Management Support Project



A substantial part of our budget once again was spent on upgrading the facilities of some of the centres. Two centres were moved to stands acquired by the Trust and wonderful teams of volunteers helped us to clean up their premises, paint their shacks and establish outdoor playgrounds.
